

Galaxy Got Talent 2019 Showcases Team Members' Talents

It is GEG's greatest hope that everyone – contestants, crew, team members and their families in the audience – enjoys The Moment." Richmond Fellowship of Macau, Caritas Macau, the Macau Association for the Mentally Handicapped, and Kanner's Home for the Autistic.

GEG also co-hosted a carnival on Broadway Food Street with AMHA as an outreach event for this year's Galaxy Got Talent. The aim of the carnival was to promote integration for persons of all abilities by creating an opportunity for them to enjoy a whole range of games and activities, along with the performances by Galaxy Got Talent contestants. The carnival was open to all members of the public, including residents and tourists, as well as 500 members of the AMHA, escorted by GEG volunteers. An interactive zone was set up to allow able-bodied participants to experience the restrictions faced by people with disabilities.
