

33 Students Complete GEG Internship Program

June 27, 2017 – Galaxy Entertainment Group ("GEG") launched the GEG Internship Program in 2008 to cultivate local talent, providing training opportunities for students to hone their strengths and broaden their horizons. Recently, GEG held the 2017 first batch GEG Internship Program Appreciation Gathering to commemorate the achievements of its latest batch of interns.
