

Galaxy Entertainment Group Donates MOP1,000,000 to Assist the victims of Gansu Mudslides

August 18, 2010 – Galaxy Entertainment Group ("GEG") donated MOP 1,000,000 today to assist the victims affected by the Gansu Zhouqu mudslides. Lastly, GEG would also like to extend our highest regards to those selfless and fearless relief crews and rescuers for their countless effort on the recovery works."

On the National Day of Mourning for Gansu mudslides victims on August 15, StarWorld Hotel, a property of GEG – in its entirety – delivered its members' deepest condolence to fellow comrades in Zhouqu County by observing a three-minute silence at the hotel's lobby and staff dining area. In addition, flags in hotel area were also flown at half-mast while all entertainment performances were suspended for the day.
