"As a Chinese, I feel so shocked and depressed to see the damages and destroys brought by the earthquakes to my fellow compatriots' lives and properties," Mr. Lui added. "As the impact of this disaster is huge, it needs assistance from all sectors to help the victims. GEG hopes to make a contribution to assist the victims and help them overcoming this disaster and rebuilding their lives and home."

Mr. Lui added, “Today, I would like to donate MOP3 million to the Liaison Office on behalf of GEG. This donation also represents the regards of every staff in GEG. We are confident that our donation will be sent to the affected areas as soon as possible.”
