

<u>GEG Inaugurates the "Integrated Resort Youth Development Program" in Collaboration with DSAL to Cultivate Local Talents for the Integrated Tourism and Leisure Sector</u>

May 23, 2023 – Galaxy Entertainment Group ("GEG") proactively supports the Macau SAR Government's policy of "Building Macau through Talent Training" through multipronged approaches to support holistic development and priority employment of local talents and to contribute to the sustainable development of the integrated resort industry. period, including training on the renowned Asian Heart service philosophy and a diverse and extensive range of pre-employment and on-the-job training conceived and arranged by various GEG departments. These trainings aim at equipping the participants with a holistic understanding of GEG's hospitality culture and development prospects, whilst helping them acquire the practical knowledge and skills in their daily work. In addition, the Program also offers participants with a wide array of professional certification training opportunities, helping them to gain various international accreditation in areas such as wine, tea art, food safety, housekeeping supervision, and management and leadership, so that they can strengthen their competitive advantage and enhance their vertical mobility.
